

The S C Witting Trust: Guidelines for Applicants

OBJECTS	Relief of poor persons or students who are following a course of study at university, ordinarily resident in Britain, Germany or Poland.
FUNDING PRIORITIES	Grants for <i>specific</i> items
TYPES OF GRANTS	Small one-off sums: £100 for students, £200 for relief of those in financial need
TYPE OF BENEFICIARY	For the benefit of individuals only: poor persons in need; or students following a course of study at university
RESTRICTIONS	The Trust does <i>not</i> pay debts, tuition fees, living expenses or make loans
BENEFICIAL AREA	England, Germany, Poland
TRUSTEES	Friends Trusts Limited

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

- Applications must be made in writing by social workers or their equivalents, except students who may apply on their own behalf with letter of support (indicating your financial need) from a tutor. Apart from students, cheques must be made payable to a third party agency so please confirm to whom the cheque should be made payable.
- Student applications can only be considered if they are in university at time of applying. Proof of this is required.
- The applications must give a *short* case history, reasons for need and amount needed.
- Applications are considered monthly and unsuccessful applications will not be acknowledged unless a self addressed stamped envelope is provided.
- Documentation from unsuccessful applications is not held, but destroyed securely. In the event of a reapplication, all relevant documents/information will need to be resubmitted.
