Getting started



Choose a venue

There are plenty of options when it comes to choosing your venue. Pubs and social clubs are great places to host your Quiz Night, or you could keep it closer to home and have it at your house or workplace.

Make a Facebook group, put posters up in your local community!



Pick a date

Choose your date carefully - make sure you are aware of any major sporting events & school holidays so that you can work around them or incorporate them into your event.



Get everyone invloved

Make sure you get your family, friends and colleagues involved. Making a Facebook event is a great way of inviting everyone along and making sure they have all the information they need.

Put posters up in and around the venue and your local community.

Sell tickets

Selling tickets is the easiest way to bring in money. Charge £5 per ticket - if you have 10 teams of 5 people, you'll raise £250 which could help a struggling family to replace a broken-down washing machine



Collections

Bring a collection box to encourage donations on the day - if you are hosting your quiz in a pub, the bar is a perfect location for people to drop their change.



Have a raffle

Think about what the prize for the winning team will be. You can ask local businesses if they would donate prizes or even sponsor your event. We can provide an authorisation letter to support you with this.



Cake Sale

Get baking or ask friends and family to bring some tasty treats and sell them during the break.


